1. WELCOME THE WORLD SURF LEAGUE

2022 brought with it several new programs to the Surfing For Hope Foundation. Through our collaboration with Surfer's of Tomorrow (the dream child of our associate director Andy McKay), SFH was the host of three WSL Qualifying Series Surf Competitions. Involvement with the WSL is our way of spreading our message world wide to "Support cancer patients and their families through positive experiences"!

Our 11th Annual Longboard Competition and Benefit Weekend this past October was once again the driving force of our fundraising efforts for 2022 and raised over \$70,000 for cancer support services on the central coast. Several generous grants and private donations allowed us to run additional programs such as:

2. GROM SERIES

SFH and MoonDoggies Surf Shop hosted three surf contests for local up and coming surfers to give them surf contest experience. The contests were free and run by a volunteer staff. Trophies were hand made by Josh & Lisa Smith, a local family whose kids also participated in the series. The Grom Series is a great way for kids to learn about competition surfing, gain confidence in the water, and make new friends. Our Grom Series (and Pure Stoke program) is made possible through youth athletic grants from the Wheeler and Sharkey Foundations and the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation.



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3. CANCER SURVIVOR SURF SERIES

Inspiring and uplifting, our cancer survivors, friends, family members and medical providers, joined us twice this year at Seacrest Hotel for a day of surf lessons, yoga, lunch and inspirational talk. This year we paired our beginner surf sessions with our 4. MEMORIAL PADDLE OUT AT AVILA BEACH in late August.



5. PURE STOKE YOUTH PROGRAM

Continues to grow thanks to so many volunteers. We kept our same format of free surf lessons for children ages 3-18 whose lives have been affected by cancer in any way. Program meets on the third Saturday of the summer months (April through October)
